This project involved the fit-out of a high-end luxury retail space, aiming to create a shopping experience that embodies the brand's identity while ensuring functionality. Management: Executed within a tight timeline of 26 weeks, the project relied on close collaboration between the design team, client, contractors and Mill workers to ensure a timely and quality delivery.

QUABA Waterfront Clinic Edinburgh



We delivered a full turnkey Mechanical package for the high-end QUABA Waterfront Clinic in Edinburgh, partnering with Souness & Boyne. The scope included rooftop mechanical plant, plant room systems, HVAC, plumbing, gas mains, heat recovery systems, and clinical theatre ventilation, all installed in compliance with SHTM guidelines. Challenges such as strict healthcare regulations, tight timelines, and space constraints were effectively managed through phased handovers and optimised equipment placement. The project was completed on time and within budget, resulting in a state-of-the-art, fully compliant medical facility designed for patient comfort and future healthcare advancements.

Spire Didsbury Manchester

Spire Healthcare acquired one-and-a-half floors within a newly built office space in Didsbury, Manchester. Smart Systems Scotland were appointed by Souness and Boyne to carry out the complete mechanical services installation within this state-of-the-art facility which included a reception, tea prep, MRI, fluoroscopy, X-ray, ultrasound, and consulting / examination rooms.

Smart Systems Scotland carried out all mechanical works including coordination of all services, plantroom installation, gas boilers, air conditioning, LTHW / CHW, insulation, trace heating, ventilation, chilled beams, BMS controls, DHCW, drainage, water treatment, and full commissioning of the mechanical services. All plant and materials selected are compliant with HTM memorandums on design, installation, and operation used in healthcare. The contract value of this project was £1.1 million over 28 weeks.







